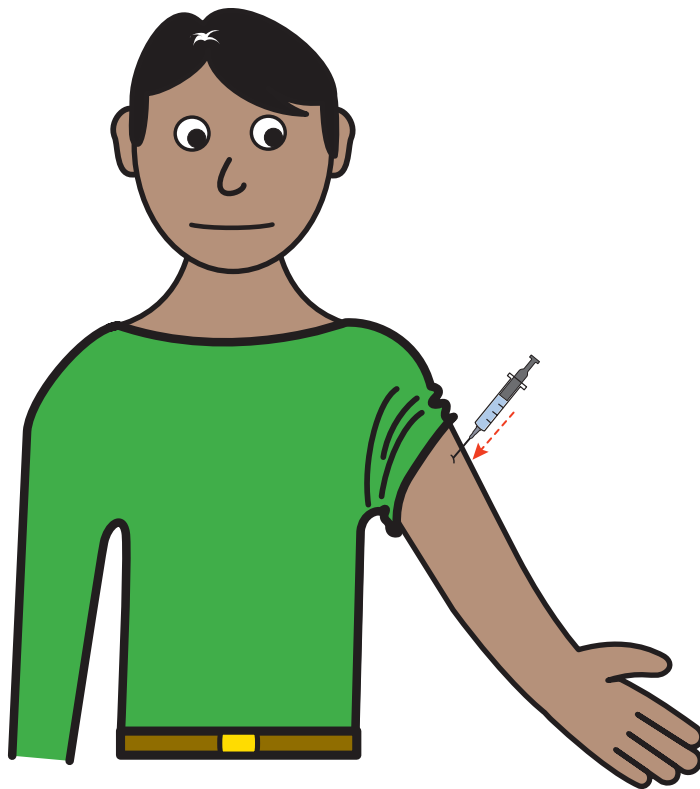

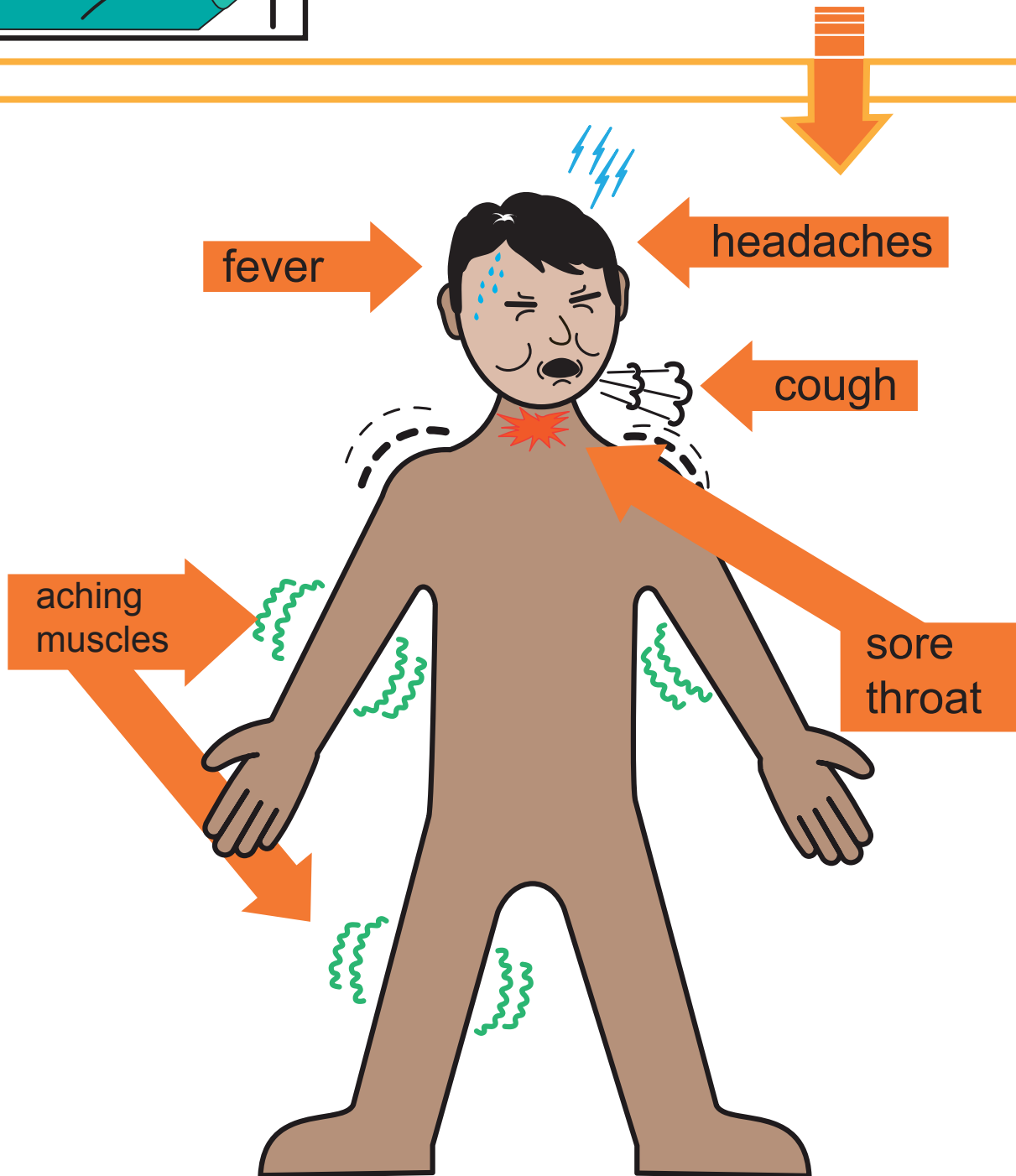

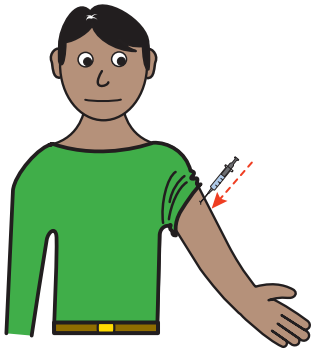
Flu can make you feel very ill.

People with Learning Disabilities and people in hospital need to take special care of their health and not get flu.

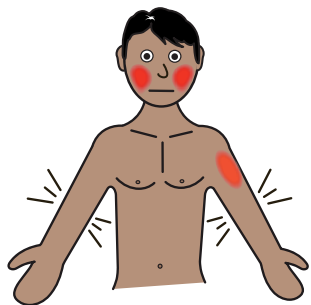

This works for most people.

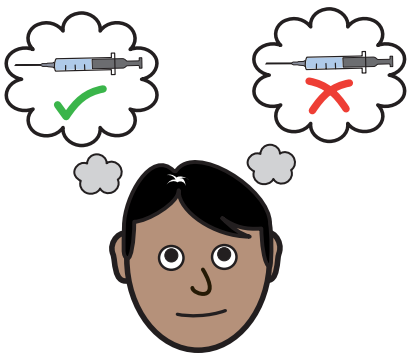
possible side effects



Sometimes people find that the injection can give them:

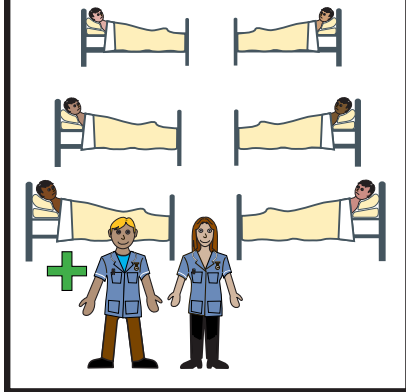
- a temperature

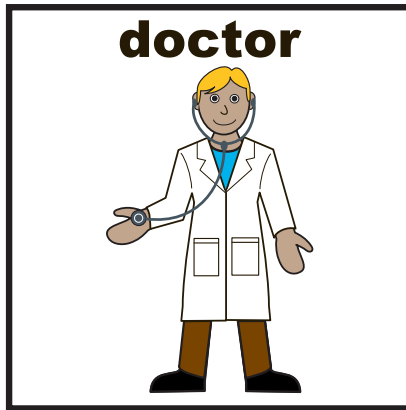

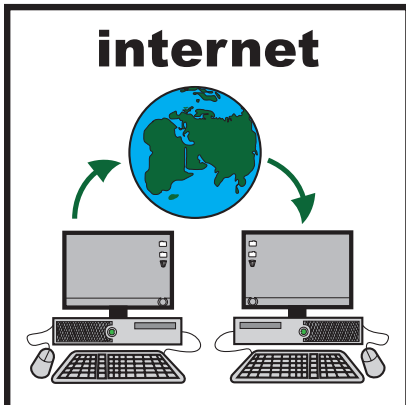
